## SUGGESTED PACKING LIST (campers do their own laundry once a week)

- Tevas or other sandal that will stay on in the water (this is mandatory for canoeing & rafting)
- 2-3 pairs of jeans or long pants (one old pair for caving)
- T-shirts and other summer tops
- 4 or 5 pairs of shorts
- blanket or quilt
- laundry bag
- inexpensive rain poncho or rain jacket
- 2 bath towels and 1 beach towel
- wash cloths and soap dish
- 1 pillow and 2 cases, 2 sets twin sheets, (bed pad optional)
- shower sandals, or type of Tevas
- pad for under sleeping bag (one that doesn't absorb water)
- extra contacts or eyeglasses if needed
- PLEASE- no cell phones** (we get no reception at the farm)  
We have hard line phones for campers to use at the farm
- a warm jacket (like a fleece jacket)
- a sweatshirt
- 2 bathing suits
- 1-2 pair pajamas
- bathrobe
- underwear & lots of socks
- sleeping bag with stuff sack
- toiletries and carrying case
- flashlight & spare batteries
- sunscreen
- sneakers (one old pair for caving and/or rafting)

## OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Light hiking boots
- Musical instruments
- Books/Journal/Photos from home
- Mountain bike (if you prefer to use your own)
- Postcards & pens (for the literate, a dying breed)
- Tennis racquet (we have some, but if you prefer your own, bring it)
- White, 100% cotton t-shirts for tie-dying, 1 or 2
- Favorite stuffed animals
- Camera (inexpensive)
- Fishing rod & reel
- Day pack or backpack
- Water bottle
- Hat

Trunks are great for packing *and* for storage.

- \* Shoes or boots with a heel are needed for riding horses (please, not hiking boots or work boots.)
- \* CD players (small boom boxes) in the bunks are "cool" for everyone to share.
- \* **Personal Walkmans, Ipods, etc. may be brought to camp for use in the bunk only for help in getting to sleep. Otherwise they are not acceptable because they encourage isolation from each other.**
- \* For International campers only---we will provide sheets, pillows, & blankets for you!
- \* Our environmental concern prompts us to ask all to be responsible. We ask campers to bring biodegradable soaps & shampoos that are available in many stores now.

## SHIPPING OF TRUNKS

If you are taking one of our vans we ask you ship the trunk ahead of time. The vans have room for carry on's only. **UPS and Fed Ex** deliver right to our camp. **9803 Old Hawn Rd., Huntingdon, PA 16652** Please contact your local pickup spot as they will often have rules for packing containers and shipping that vary. For the return trip we will ship the trunks and then let you know the cost.
